PROJECT NAME: *Designed for Healing ~ Rebirth of the Women's Hospital*

DESCRIPTION: Saddleback Memorial Foundation is partnering with the community to raise money for the "rebirth" of the Women's Hospital of Saddleback Memorial Medical Center. In 1988, the Women's Hospital was the first of its kind to open in Orange County, featuring private rooms designed for labor, delivery, recovery and post-partum. The 23-year-old facility is now in need of enhancements to provide a greater birthing and healing environment for mothers, babies and their families.

ENHANCING THE BIRTHING AND HEALING EXPERIENCE

- New, state-of-the-art birthing beds designed for ease and safety
 - Battery back-up for full bed functions are ideal for operating room transports or repositioning.
 - Stow and Go™ Foot Section enables foot section to easily slide back into place without false latching or interference with bed linens, creating a safer environment for both the patient and caregivers. Also allows caregivers to maintain access to the patient while preparing the bed for delivery.
 - Inflatable air pillows in back and seat decrease the need to reposition the patient for delivery.
 - Tempur-Pedic® beds relax the spine, providing deeper sleep that is essential for the body's recuperation and wellness.
- Technologically advanced fetal monitors used to detect baby's heartrate to determine if baby is in distress
 - New monitors will work in conjunction with special software featuring internet-based physician access.
 - Doctors will be able to view real-time information about the baby's health from another location and make vital decisions for the expectant mother and baby.
- In-room work areas with access to Wi-Fi provide space in room for fathers or guests to set up laptop computers.
- Color palettes chosen for the new paint, flooring and window treatments will reflect warm, natural earth tones, providing a calm, healing environment.
- Nurse's stations, family waiting areas and the Women's Hospital Lobby will undergo enhancements reflecting the *Designed for Healing* motif.

FUNDING NEEDS: Saddleback Memorial Foundation is partnering with the community to raise \$2.5 million to enhance the Women's Hospital.
